Ilchester Parish Council Response to Planning Proposal 23/01618/HYBRID

Introduction

IPC notes that the Somerset Local Plan designates Ilchester as a Rural Centre and as such under Policy SS3, the number of dwellings allocated to year 2028 has already been supplied. The Housing requirement within the Plan being 141 to 2028, and to date 163 have been built. We request that Somerset Council take our community's objection to this unnecessary and unwanted development into consideration in their decision making.

Concern	• How will the balance of attracting wildlife and especially birds be balanced with the number of trees planted and the danger to low-flying aircraft? (More trees attracts more birds = greater danger to aircraft. Fewer trees means less attractive to residents.) We understand there are concerns raised by the MoD.	Ecosystem
Concern	 Fosse Way is being promoted in this application as a pedestrian cycle access route to the nature reserve. How can this be safe for pedestrians when: The road surface has not been maintained for many years, Both sides of the road are overgrown, thereby narrowing the road, The road has no line markings, The road has no street lighting, The speed limit for vehicles is 60mph, There is no pedestrian footpath or cycle path for safety, Access to farm and properties there needs to be maintained. Concern	 Access from Fosse Way to the nature reserve is across a private driveway. How will access be guaranteed? 	Fosse Way
Concern	 How will car parking along Fosse Way be managed if pedestrians want to park and walk into the nature reserve from that side? 	Fosse Way

Question	 Is the car park part of this full planning application, i.e. guaranteed to be provided? 	Parking
Question	What is the car park surface to be made of / laid to?	Parking
Question	Who will maintain the car park?	Parking
Question	Will the car park be height restricted, secured at night, or charged for?	Parking
Question	 Will the car park have any public facilities, such as: Toilets, EV charging. 	Parking
Question	 How is the Ilchester Nature Trust set up / funded? How long are any funds intended to last? What is the staffing model for trustees, rangers, etc.? 	Ilchester Nature Trust
Question	 Where will 10 litres of water per day per young tree come from when there is no rainwater available? Who will be ensuring that these young trees flourish? 	Ilchester Nature Trust

Concern	 We are concerned that 1.8 million vehicle transits of Ilchester per year (measured by our Speed Indicator Device) makes entrance / exit of the proposed development dangerous, as designed, with two schools close by. More than 50% of vehicles on this road are driving over the speed limit. 	Traffic / Safety
Concern	• Ilchester currently has a Sports Pavilion, Town Hall & Community Centre. Will this proposed set- aside land for local facilities revert to house-building if there is no further demand? Noting that any construction of such a facility would have to be funded separately.	Local Facility Land
Concern	For the proposed industrial units, is access sufficient and safe for large commercial / articulated vehicles? Council are very concerned at the proposed access design.	Traffic / Safety

Concern	The recreation facilities proposed are for very young people who tend to be supervised. What is being provided for older youth, and for accessible needs?	Recreation
Concern	 We request that the land put aside for employment and local facilities be prohibited from house- building for 10 years from any granting of this application. 	Housing scope creep
Concern	 We request that construction is mandated at the highest levels of sustainability: Solar panels, Heat pumps (Air source or Ground source) instead of gas boilers, EV charging for each residential unit. 	Sustainability
Concern	 77% of our 330 survey respondents felt we already had sufficient housing: The top 3 concerns raised were: Traffic congestion, Health services, Parking This proposal will put further strain on all 3 of these. 	Village survey
Question	 Current new development (Hainbury) residents are paying a service charge on their private road. Who will own and maintain new road access to the new housing? 	Maintenance fees
Question	 Advertising for the previous public consultation did not reach many residents before the event. Can we have a public consultation which is properly advertised? 	Consultation
Question	Will the proposal provide a minimum of 2 allocated off-street parking spaces for each unit to keep the roads free from parked cars? This is in line with the latest census figures on car / van ownership.	Parking
